## SUSTAINABILTY

Ben Fish, Associate Director of Utilities Operations, joined the meeting to talked about sustainability with regard the Power Plant. He says renewable energy is getting more traction with solar and wind and then renewables. The electricity on the grid is getting cheaper, resulting a greening of the grid, as he calls it. He mentioned that with Engie as a utility partner, we could have nation-wide offerings and more opportunity to expand the use of renewables, of which we are at 40% use this year.

Discussion included philosophical trust of campus users, self-generation for grid independence, grid redundancy, continued energy assessments of building with the Fault Detection and Diagnostic (FDD) program, and the future of the water plant.
