NEW MEMBER INTRODUCTIONS

New members to the committee, David Hensley, Lauren Lessing, Alivia Rosendahl and Rachael Schaefer were welcomed to the FY20-21 CPC committee. Introductions were made around.

CLEAN-UP OF BUILDINGS AND WALKWAYS

Scott Gritsch, Associate Director of Landscape Services, reported on the progress of the graffiti cleanup across campus. Shadowing/ghosting from the graffiti that remain, and potential protections of future events were discussed.

SPACE CHANGES TO ACCOMMODATE TEACHING WITH SOCIAL DISTANCING

Joe Bilotta reported on space changes to accommodate teaching and social distancing in academic buildings. During this Fall Semester, approximately 25% of classes are face to face, with the remaining classes begin taught online or in a hybrid version. Building circulation plans for flow of pedestrian traffic, seating evaluation of class space, guidelines for holding events, air circulation and filtrations of buildings, density of dorm rooms and new processes for dining halls were discussed.

CAMPUS MASTER PLAN PROGRESS – ILLUSTRATIVE PLANS

Joe Bilotta presented progress on the Campus Master plan in illustrative views. Sections that were shared included the Parklawn/Band Practice area, Seashore Hall area, Art Campus, and Melrose/Burlington Corridor. Discussion also included the CRANDIC rails to trails study and a conceptual plan for a people mover that would connect space on the East and West campuses.
