### **SUICIDE PREVENTION SIGNAGE**

Representatives from the Division of Student Life presented a proposal for signage in an effort to develop a culture of suicide prevention across campus.

This signage campaign would place several 12" x 18" signs in high traffic locations across campus such as bridges, parking ramps, Hubbard Park, etc. The goal would be increased repeat exposure.

This proposal was supported by committee members.

### **SPACE COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS**

Because CPC has a role in considering, recommending and adopting guidelines for space use, committee members were updated on current discussions for hybrid use on campus.
