GIBSON SQUARE ART

With the kind contribution from a donor alumnus, a select few pieces of art will be conserved and then placed in the Gibson Square area near the new Stanley Museum of Art. The vision is to allow community to begin exploring and engaging with art even before coming into the museum.

Discussion included considering placement that will be protected from ice and snow removal during the winter months; the importance of identification of each piece; protection from potential flooding due to location; and accessibility.

Committee members expressed support for these installations.

OLD CAPITOL BANNERS

A request for periodic display of banners at the Old Capitol was reviewed. The specific banner example showed the branded Iowa logo with the anticipation of them being displayed during events such as homecoming, graduation, welcome week, e.g., as well as banners connected to exhibits at the Old Capitol Museum.

Discussion included current policy parameters of the periodic use and judicious review of content.

Committee members supported the black Iowa banner with gold lettering.

CROSSWALKS ON JEFFERSON AND MARKET STREETS

A request to create a traffic calming pattern to the crosswalks at the intersections of T. Anne Cleary Walkway with Jefferson and Markets streets was reviewed. The example depicted was a large Tiger Hawk.
