### **DENTAL SCIENCE BUILDING – RELOCATE BASEMENT GENERATOR**

Currently, the building’s diesel generator is located in the southwest corner of the basement. This proposal would convert this generator to natural gas and move it outside for placement on a pad near the loading dock area. Many sites were considered though an extensive utility infrastructure limits its placement.

Discussion included screening of the generator and stack and potential conflict with planned roadway changes (UIHC Master Plan).

Committee members supported this proposal.

### **CENTER/PROGRAM NAMING WITHIN THE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION**

As part of the process for a major naming on campus, a proposal was shared that would rename a Center within the College of Education. With a generous gift funded by the Scanlan Foundation, the Iowa Center for School of Mental Health will be renamed the Scanlan Center for School of Mental Health.

The purpose of the Center is to provide social, emotional, behavioral, and psychological services to schools, not only to aid in COVID-19 recovery but to build capacity for immediate and future delivery of mental health supports across the state. The Center will bring together educational partners, policymakers, and mental health professionals to serve as a national hub for research-to-practice implementation related to mental health. This transformational gift from the Scanlan Family Foundation will support the Iowa Center for School Mental Health’s Clinical Services as well as activities and programs of the Center that support the mental health needs of veterans, those serving in the military, and their families.
