HAWKINS DRIVE ART

At the corner of the Hawkins Drive and Highway 6 intersection, a temporary mural made of wheat paste is being vetted. In celebration of the City of Coralville's 150th anniversary, artist Isaac Campbell along with community partnerships is being considered. The art would be removed by August 14, 2023, in preparation for the campus gateway project.

Discussion included consultation with the Iowa City Art Advisory Committee and consideration of the Visual Artists Rights Act.

BUILDING IMPROVEMENT PLAN

SPACE POLICIES

Working with the Space Committee, a first draft of part 1 of the Space Policies plan has been presented to the Dean's Council. Organization of the policies are divided into four Sections including Intent, Management, Data Management and Planning and Use. Key Elements would include Clarity - Decentralized System, Management and Responsibility, Hybrid Work Impacts, Multiple Office Guidelines, Design Guidelines and Utilization Expectations. Once formalized by the Deans and coordinated with the non-academic units they will be recommended for inclusion in our Operations Manual.

The draft Space Policies and Guidelines will be sent to Committee members for their comments. Once gathered, Lois Geist and Maggie Vogel will attend a meeting to review results.
