Staff Council

Maria Bruno, representing our Staff Council, surveyed committee members of what experience and knowledge base would they recommend representing this committee.

Parking Lots and Ramps – Dental Parking Ramp

Conceptual designs for the Dental Parking Ramp (NKA: Arena Parking Ramp) were presented.

This five-level structure, with the first level designed as a walkout, will be located between Carver Hawkeye Arena and the Dental Science Building in the location of the northeast section of the Dental Science Building parking lot. This facility will be approximately 10-12 feet higher than the Dental Science Building. The entrance of the ramp will be off Newton Road. The façade will include mesh cladding allowing for views in and out and revealing illumination at night; curtain walls at the east and west walls; and kinetic features on the southside that move with the air current; and the stairwells will be glass. These design features were drawn from existing area structures.

Discussion included parking spaces lost or gained by this project, use by staff permit holders, the accommodation of additional levels, changes to pedestrian traffic in this area and display of UIHC or UI branding.

Committee members supported this project as presented.

Gymnastics and Spirit Squad Building Renaming

Rod Lehnertz brought a facility renaming to CPC as part of the named building process. The facility being built to accommodate the Gymnastics and Spirit Squad

is intended to be named the “Nagle-Duda Gymnastics and Spirit Squad Training Facility pending approval by the Board of Regents at the January 14, 2025, session.
